



Email subscription to Grants.gov funding announcements –

- 1. Provides daily notification of all new funding opportunity announcements (FOAs)**
- 2. Provides updates and notifications of changes to Grants.gov, new tips for users and time sensitive bulletins**
- 3. Provides updates based on selected advanced criteria (e.g. funding mechanism, eligibility or sub-agency)**
- 4. Provides notification of changes to selected FOA**

Types of Funding Opportunity Announcements –

PA – Program Announcement

- Identifies broader areas of increased priority and/or emphasis of the agency (NIH, AHRQ); usually offered by more than one agency**
- Usually posted as an ongoing opportunity (~3 yrs.)**
- Standard receipt dates – June 5, October 5 and February 5 of each year**

PAR

- Program announcement (PA) with special receipt (R) date or review (R)**

PAS

- Program announcement (PA) that includes special set aside funds (S)**

RFAs – Request for Applications

- Identifies more narrowly defined research area with set aside funds**

RFA-DK-08-504 (DK – Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases)

- Usually accepted on a single receipt date**
